Benefits of Utilising Technology to Support the Delivery of Care



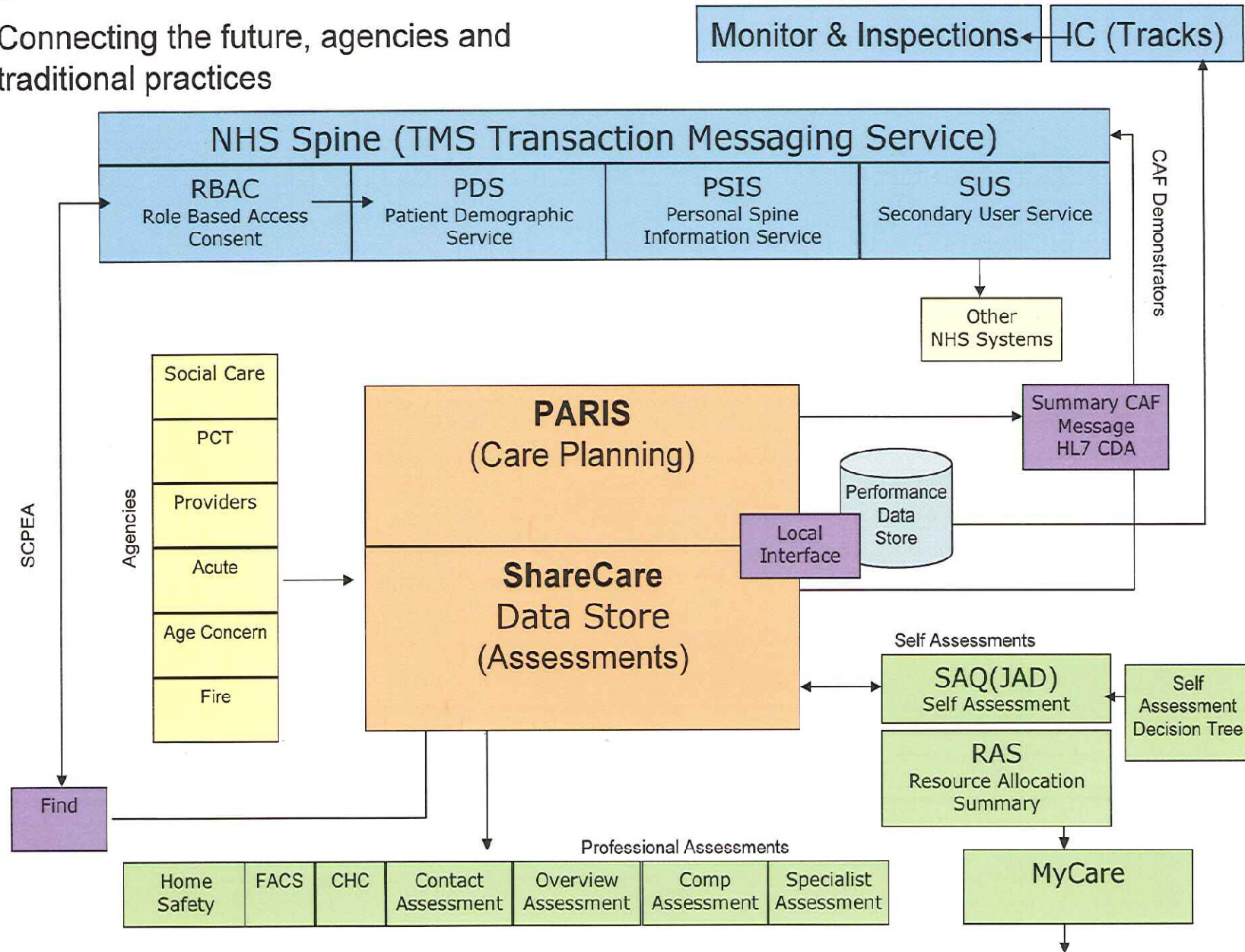
- Social Care Redesign – Personalisation Agenda

Ongoing Projects

- Implementation of PARIS system
- Electronic Service Return Portal (ESRP) – Managing electronic submissions by providers
- PARIS – CSAP (ShareCare) Interface
- Common Assessment Framework. Key Benefits:
 - Reduced data entry (PARIS/ShareCare data sharing)
 - User/carer self-service using personalised budgets/self-funding
 - Better support for service users at critical life stages (continuing healthcare, delayed discharge, EoLC)
 - Extensions of assessment forms and information sharing to more partners and specialist services
 - Better profiling of service users – more responsive service planning
